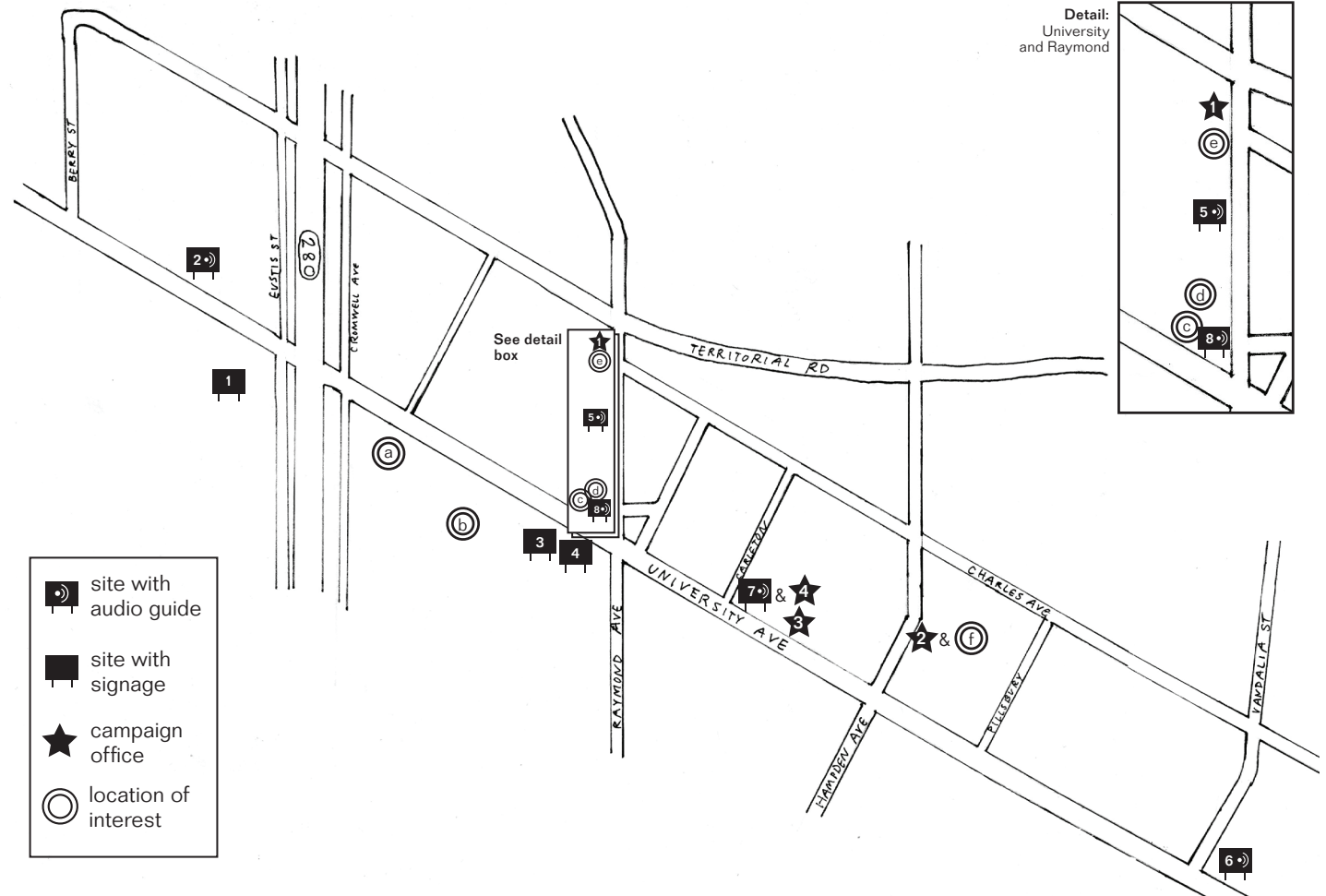




**St. Anthony
